**FILMING ON LUDGATE HILL**  
**SATURDAY 7<sup>TH</sup> & SUNDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2026**

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to inform you of some upcoming filming dates planned to take place on Ludgate Hill on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2026. This is for a new upcoming Netflix feature-film called 'Hawksmoor'. All filming is being planned in conjunction with the support of the City of London Film Office.

Our overall plan with key dates and times are as follows:

**Filming Areas & Road Closure**

The filming will take place at three main points along Ludgate Hill, namely on the St Paul's Churchyard junction with Ludgate Hill, the middle of Ludgate Hill to the east of the Old Bailey junction, and then further west, near the Ludgate Circus end outside of the Leon restaurant. The scenes we are filming involve a gridlocked traffic jam with large crowds of supporting artists in the road, as well as the use of SFX rain effects and SFX fire & smoke effects.

In order to facilitate our preparation and filming day, we will be establishing a Traffic Management Road Closure from 08:00 hours on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> to 23:00 hours on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March, to safely close Ludgate Hill to vehicles and manage pedestrian movement. The road closure will be from Ludgate Circus to the Godliman Street junction. Within this closure, we will have two large cranes and five telehandler machines rigged with rain effects equipment, blue screens and sun blocker frames positioned at specific points along the street. These will be instated on Saturday morning after 0800 hrs, with some trackway being quietly laid on the pavement next to St Paul's Cathedral from 0700 hrs. They will then be dismantled and removed from site quietly between 18:00 – 23:00 hours on Sunday evening.

The proposed Traffic Management Road Closure Plan can be seen on the map overleaf.

Pedestrian access to properties and buildings will, of course, be maintained, however, members of public may be politely asked to wait for several minutes if we are in the middle of moving some machinery or filming a take, until we have cut and it is safe to proceed. Equally, due to moving vehicles and filming equipment, pedestrian access to the pavements to the north of Ludgate Hill will be limited on the Sunday to a few specific crossing areas; in this way, businesses and properties may still be accessed safely when required.

Every effort will be made to work as quietly as possible at all times in order to not disturb the local residents, especially during the early and late hours, with multiple marshals and security guards on site to manage noise levels and to ensure all crew work in a safe, quiet and respectful manner.

When planning our filming, we aim to cause as little disruption to the local residents, organisations and businesses as possible. To that end, we would like to welcome any feedback or concerns that you may have by contacting us on the details below. 
